The Neuse Little Theatre is excited for our 51st season, and we invite you to become a part of its season membership. We have five diverse shows that to appeal to everyone.!

The season opens with a literary classic about a young girl looking for a home and a place to belong, followed by a show with a series of vignettes taking place in a mall on the night before Christmas, then a musical about falling in love sight unseen and maybe we need to look deeper at those around us to see what's always been in front of us, followed by a drama about faith and insecurities, and to finish the season, a classic theatrical comedy about two unsuited roommates.

Few small communities have experienced the quality of local theatre that has graced Johnston County's stages. From its founding 50 years ago, the Neuse Little Theatre has maintained the highest standards of quality. From Neil Simon to Rogers & Hammerstein; from *Spoon River Anthology* to *The Wizard of Oz*, NLT has strived to delight young and old alike.

After years of traveling from pillar to post in search of a home, the Neuse Little Theatre has a place to call its own. "The Hut", as it is affectionately known, is NLT's home.
